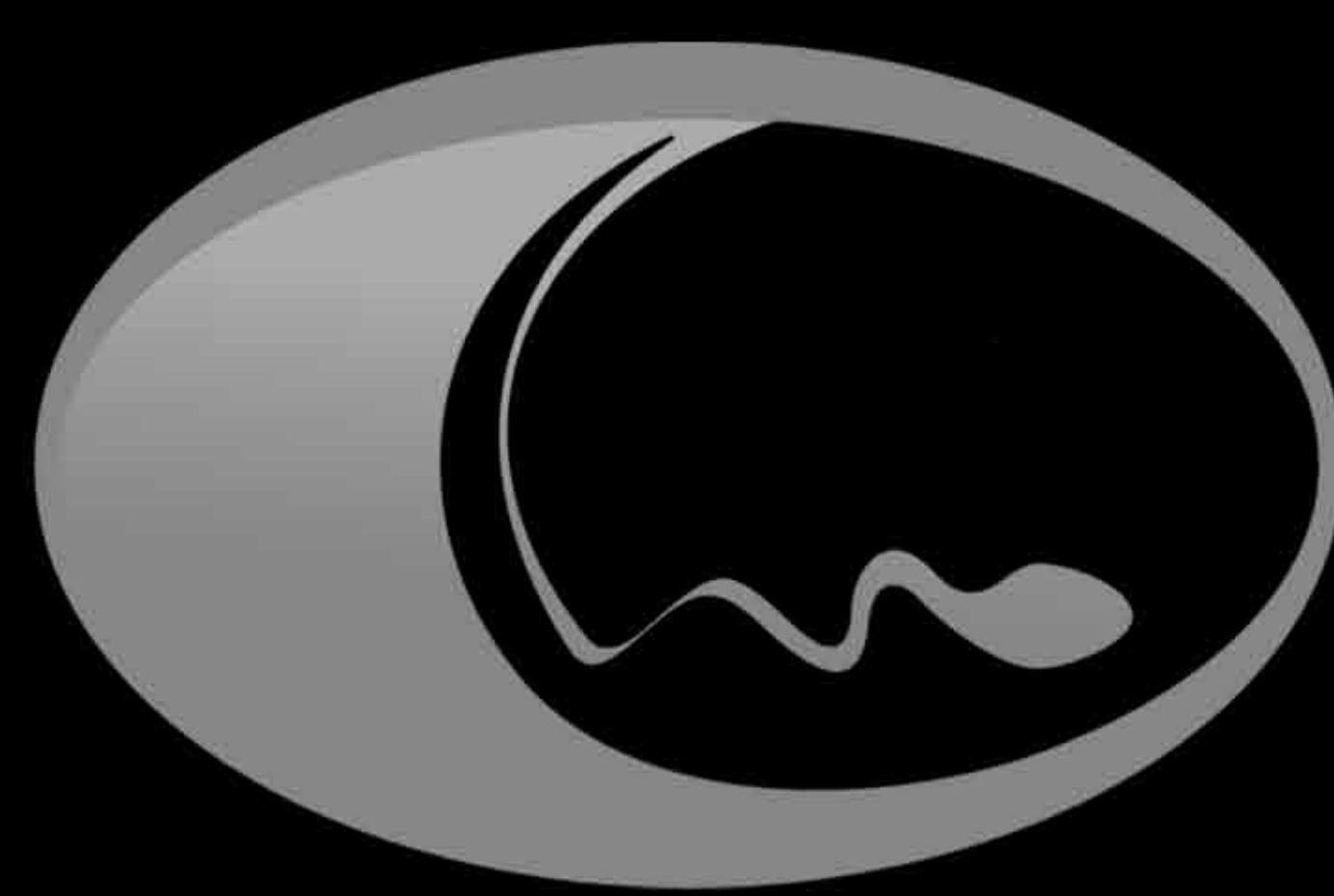
THE MASTER IN EQUINE CLONING

In 2003 the team of Avantea, lead by Prof. Cesare Galli, obtained the world-first horse clone. She was named Prometea, after the Titan hero of Greek mythology and champion of mankind. Prometea is on the right, beside Cesare Galli. The original mare from which she was cloned is on the left.

In 2007 Prometea gave birth to a healthy colt, named Pegaso, following artificial insemination. At present she is happily enjoying life at Avantea premises, live witness of the power and safety of horse cloning technology.
